



MASAI MARA- DAILY DEPARTURE

Day 1: Nairobi/Arrival

On arrival JKIA, you are met by a Nature Expeditions representative drive to Maasai Mara Game Reserve, so named to mean the “spotted plains” in Maa language. This is home to the greatest concentration of large mammals and is widely recognized as Africa’s ultimate wildlife reserve. The park is the northern extension to the vast Serengeti-Mara ecosystem, famous for its annual migration of wildebeest. Arrive and check-in at the Camp in time for lunch. Depart later for an evening game viewing drive in the Reserve which is a spectacular place of breathtaking sceneries, never-ending plains and the most abundant variety of wildlife remaining anywhere in the world. All meals and overnight at **Nyumbu Camp (Full Board)**

Day 2: Maasai Mara

Spend a further day in the Reserve on morning and afternoon game viewing drives. Wildlife is abundant in the Reserve with the gentle grasslands ensuring that animals are never out of sight. Birds are prolific including immigrants, 450 bird species have been recorded among them 57 birds of prey. Every year the Mara plays host to the world’s greatest natural spectacle; The Great Wildebeest Migration from the Serengeti. They converge across the border into the Mara, making a spectacular entrance. The big cats - lion, leopard, and cheetah - follow the wildebeest, essentially their main source of food, into the Mara. **Visit a Maasai tribal village and enjoy entertainment by Maasai dancers** All meals and overnight Nyumbu Camp (Full Board)
